11h) Management	<p>A Director of the Board shall vacate office:-</p> <p>(i) if he/she is absent from three consecutive Board meetings without leave of absence or not being represented by proxy;</p> <p>(ii) if he/she is being represented by a proxy for 4 consecutive meetings; or</p> <p>(iii) if his/her appointment as representative is withdrawn or cancelled by the Member he/she represents.</p>	<p>A Director of the Board shall vacate office:-</p> <p>(i) if he/she is absent from three consecutive Board meetings without leave of absence.</p> <p>(ii) if his/her appointment as representative is withdrawn or cancelled by the Member he/she represents.</p>	<p><u>Change:</u> Removal of statement (ii) associated with proxy.</p> <p>Promote direct participation and active engagement by Board Directors at board meeting to ensure that key discussions and decisions are handled by committed, present members of the Board.</p>
